Call to Order and Introductions – TAC Chair Bruce Eckard called the meeting to order and welcomed all present at 2:30 PM. Introductions were not made, since meeting was conducted online via Go To Meeting with names appearing for those joining the virtual meeting.

Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) Report – In place of TCC John Marshall, Brian Horton shared information items from the prior TCC meeting. All items had been unanimously recommended by TCC to TAC.

Action Items:

- **I. Approval of Minutes** Chair Eckard asked members if they had a chance to review the minutes. Upon a motion from Mr. Taylor and a second by Mr. Morrow, the minutes of the April 29, 2020, TAC meeting were unanimously approved.
- II. Locally Administered Project Program (LAPP) Applications and Scores Mr. Horton explained the MPO issued a call for projects back in April for approximately \$13 million in Surface Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funding over Fiscal Years 2021, 2022, and 2023. Mr. Horton presented an overview of the five new and two

supplemental LAPP projects received from Burke County, City of Conover, City of Hickory (three projects), Town of Hildebran, and Town of Hudson. Mr. Horton also noted that Greenway Public Transportation would utilize the 10% portion of annual STBG-DA funding for preventive maintenance. Chair Eckard confirmed there were no TAC member objections to releasing the LAPP projects and scores for public comment.

- III. COVID-19 Travel Trends Mr. Cavanaugh presented line graphs for each of the four counties in the region showing reduction in travel since the declaration of the pandemic in mid-March through the start of the Governor's Phase-1 re-opening in early May. Mr Cavanaugh noted that the data come from aggregated, anonymized mobile phone locations. The line graphs showed travel dropping well before the Governor's Stay-at-Home Order in late March, a common low point around Easter, and since then, a climb back towards average Vehicle Miles Traveled. Since this was an information item, no action was required.
- IV. NCDOT Revenue Challenges Mr. Horton noted, in light of reduced travel, that fuel consumption and revenues had also greatly declined. Mr. Horton presented slides that the NCDOT Secretary had given in late April to the NC First Commission that covered the financial challenges facing NCDOT, as well as potential scenarios for recovery. Mr. Horton stressed that the financial situation had already been strained before COVID, due to multiple storms, including heavy rainfall events in the region. The pandemic would greatly exacerbate this decline in reserves by now losing over \$300 million in revenue. The scenarios presented to recover would depend on the amount of federal or state aid, including the possibility of not recovering until 2022. Mr. Tarleton noted that the figure he had heard required for full recovery was \$850 million, factoring both the pre- and post-COVID declines in cash reserves. Since this was an information item, no action was required.
- V. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Revisions for Board of Transportation Mr. Horton noted one of the actions being taken in response to declining revenues was to delay the capital program of projects. Mr. Horton noted the local TIP revisions to be considered today match the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) revisions that recently went to the State Board of Transportation earlier that same month. Mr. Horton presented slides by each county, calling out how many each project would now be delayed, compared with their prior schedule. Upon a motion from Mr. Taylor and a second by Mr. Townsend, TAC members unanimously approved the TIP revisions.

NCDOT Update - NCDOT presented the following updates:

- *NC Board of Transportation* Mr. Pope and Mr. Tarleton each shared the recent financial challenges facing NCDOT.
- Division 11 Mr. Pettyjohn shared mowing would hopefully resume soon.
- Division 12 Mr. Stafford noted the limited updates, in light of finances.
- Division 13 In place of Mr. Gibbs, Mr. Sparks shared an update of Burke projects.
- NCDOT-TPD Ms. Pam Cook gave an update referring to her newsletter.

Added public comments or announcements:

No public comment.

Adjournment – As there was no other business, Mr. Eckard thanked our guests and adjourned the meeting at 3:28 PM. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for June 24, 2020.



RESOLUTION DIRECTING STBG-DA FUNDS TO LOCAL PRIORITY PROJECTS

A motion was made by TAC Member _____ and seconded by TAC Member

for the adoption of the following resolution, and upon being put to a vote was duly adopted.
WHEREAS, the Greater Hickory Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is a Transportation Management Area and has the authority to direct available Federal Highway program Surface Transportation Block Grant – Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) obligation authority to MPO area local projects; AND
WHEREAS, allocation of STBG-DA obligation authority to enable work on six area priority projects to proceed totaling \$15,925,000 (\$12,740,000 in STBG-DA funds and \$3,185,000 in local match), as shown in the Attachment II at the July 24, 2020, TAC Meeting; AND
WHEREAS, the proposed project recommendations and recommended actions have been developed in coordination with the North Carolina Department of Transportation; AND
NOW THEREFORE be it resolved , by the Greater Hickory MPO Transportation Advisory Committee, to approve the direction of \$12,740,000 in STBG-DA funds on this, the 27 th day of July, 2020.
