Catawba County S.T.A.R. Drug Treatment Court (Supervision, Treatment, Accountability, & Recovery) is a post adjudication, voluntary, supervised, holistic, cognitive based, judicially mandated, intensive treatment program for offenders who have been identified as having a problem with drugs and/or alcohol. It has been in operation for 18 years and is a multi-agency program that consists of the presiding Judge, Assistant District Attorney, Defense Attorney, NC Division of Community Corrections, Law Enforcement Officer, Treatment Provider,

Mental Health Liaison, Drug Treatment Court Coordinator, TASC and Peer Support Specialists. The target populations for the program are high risk/high need adult, nonviolent offenders convicted of DWI Level I and II, Class H or I Felony, Misdemeanor drug conviction, and/or felony or misdemeanor conviction other than a drug conviction if drugs or alcohol was a contributing factor in the crime committed. The program consists of 3 Phases, lasting not less than 12 months and not more than 24 months in total, unless extended by the S.T.A.R. Drug Treatment Court Team.

The S.T.A. R. DTC Program is designed as an alternative to incarceration. It is the primary goal of the S.T.A.R. Drug Treatment Court Program to help individuals achieve long-term recovery; improve their quality of life, foster healthy relationships; and to become responsible productive citizens therefore increasing community safety.

FIRST offers population specific components for Veterans through the United States Dept. of Veterans Affairs and for those involved with the criminal justice system either on probation, or returning from state custody through the NC Dept. of Public Safety. FIRST also offers Residential Medication Assisted Treatment and Recovery for those who qualify.

"Groups is a community you can rely on to recover from opiate use and regain control of your life. We provide effective, affordable and convenient treatment to recover from opiate use. We combine two of the most powerful tools for recovery: group therapy and medication-assisted treatment (Suboxone). Alternatives are available for referrals made by the criminal justice system.

Unlike programs where you meet alone with a physician, we bring everyone together for group therapy-physicians, counselors, and recovering opiate users. The group meets for one hour weekly. People at different stages of recovery learn from each other, build collective wisdom, and hold each other accountable. Our counselors help you make a deep personal transformation and find purpose in life.

Our program also prescribes buprenorphine (Suboxone), which has been shown to be the most effective way to treat opiate dependence. Most people are typically on medication for 18-24 months, but remain part of the Groups community for life.

TRANSFORMATION JOURNEY, INC.

Transformation Journey, Inc. provides educational services for incarcerated male offenders in preparation for their transition back into public life that are currently being offered at Foothills Minimum Custody. The program consists of a Spring and Fall Semester, with a 13-week curriculum, meeting weekly in two-hour sessions on critical life skills necessary for these individuals to make a successful transition back into society and ultimately reduce the rate of recidivism. The material presented is Christ-centered and Biblically-based.

Inmates are invited to an informational meeting prior to the start of each semester, where they can enroll in the upcoming semester. Program participants (inmates) work in teams with class advisors (volunteers). Each team of 3-4 students has a class advisor who facilitates their Table Talk times. Class sessions are informal, consisting of 15-20 students, using different presentation formats by a variety of instructors. Students are given the opportunity and encouraged to be contributing participants. They have an opportunity to work in teams, share ideas, express their own questions, and concerns, etc.

Through our website, the graduates and their families are provided with a link on line to a large variety of resources available in each county in North Carolina. They are also given links to NC Commerce and NC Works sites. They are encouraged to stay in contact after release by using the contact, information update form and stamped, self-addressed envelope.
